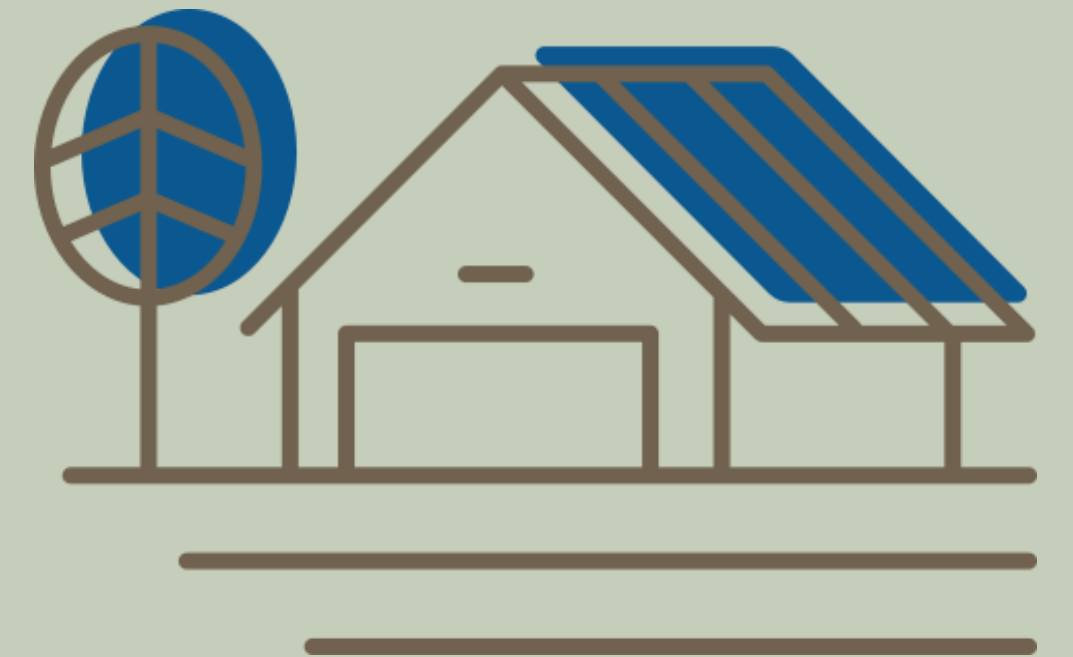

VALUE OF THE EVA

Over the years, the Erindale Village Association has undertaken a large number of initiatives on behalf of the residents that directly improved the quality of life in our community. Some examples include:

- ✓ Traffic light installation at Robinson and Dundas and the adjustment of the timing when light changes were long.
- ✓ Introduction of the Neighbourhood watch program with Safe City Mississauga
- ✓ Increased safety by installing new stop sign at the corner of Proudfoot and Adamson
- ✓ No parking signs along one side of each road

VALUE OF THE EVA

- Stops to slow speeding on Jarvis
- Rapid repairs to signs that become damaged
- Holding consultation meetings with our local MP and City Councilor
- Advocacy on development issues in our neighbourhood
- Building connections and friendships among neighbours
- Recognizing our heritage through revised street signs in the village
- Holding annual events like the Spring and Fall Festivals that enriches our quality of life and provides a shared sense of community kinship for our residents.

VALUE OF THE EVA

The Erindale Village Association was formed to act as stewards of our unique history and the ecological importance of the area where we are located.

In addition, the Erindale Village Association actively participates in issues that impact our community through advocacy, communication and collaboration with its residents and within our greater community.

The Association undertakes activities to create, foster and maintain a community spirit and works cooperatively to make our neighbourhood a better place to live.

MEMBERSHIP

Thanks to all members of the EVA Board, who canvassed the neighbourhood for membership, and thanks to all who paid the 2025 membership. 84% of the residents joined in 2025.

There are 139 possible locations in Erindale. Of these 6 are not currently occupied, leaving 133 possible members.

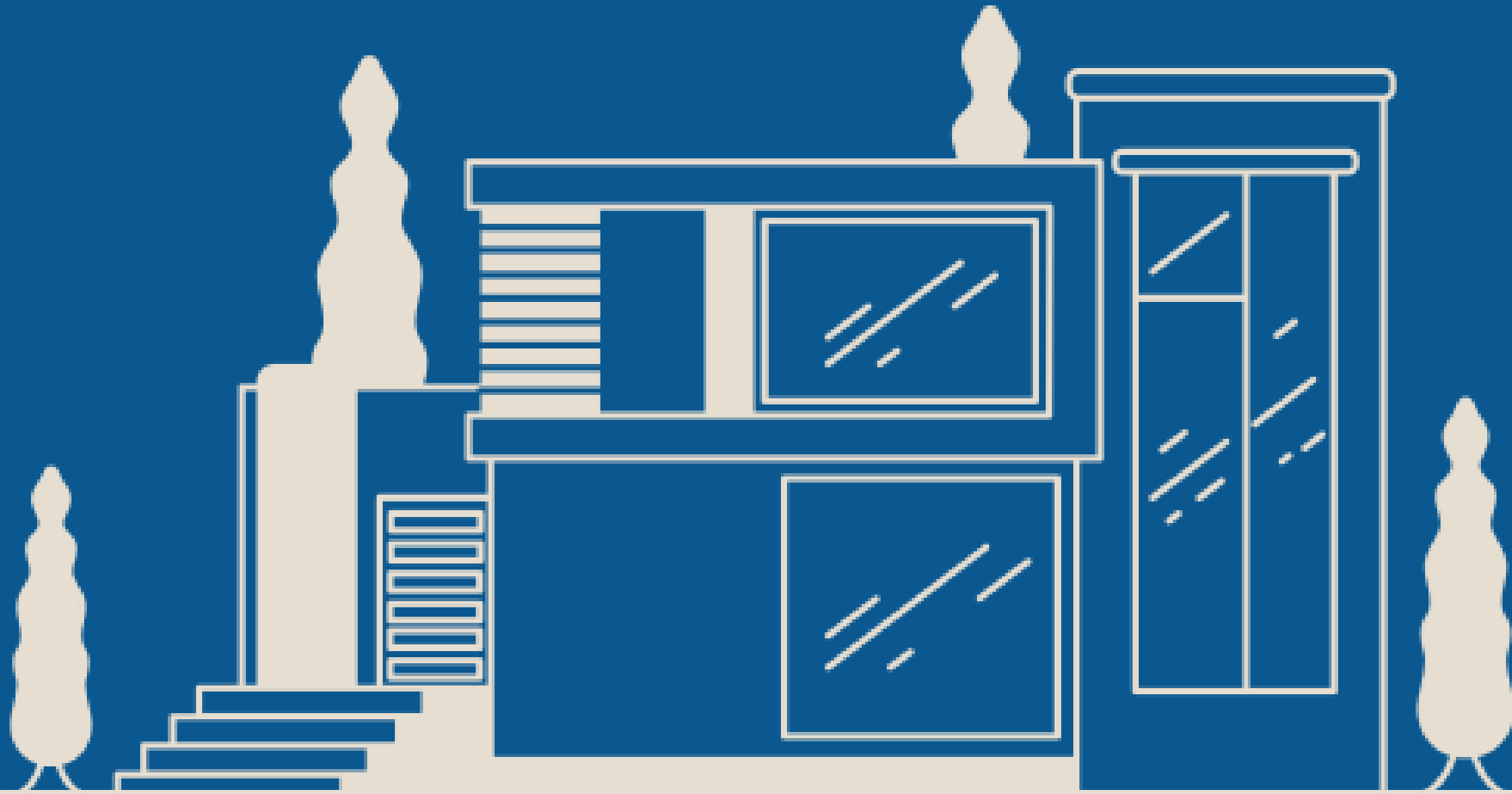

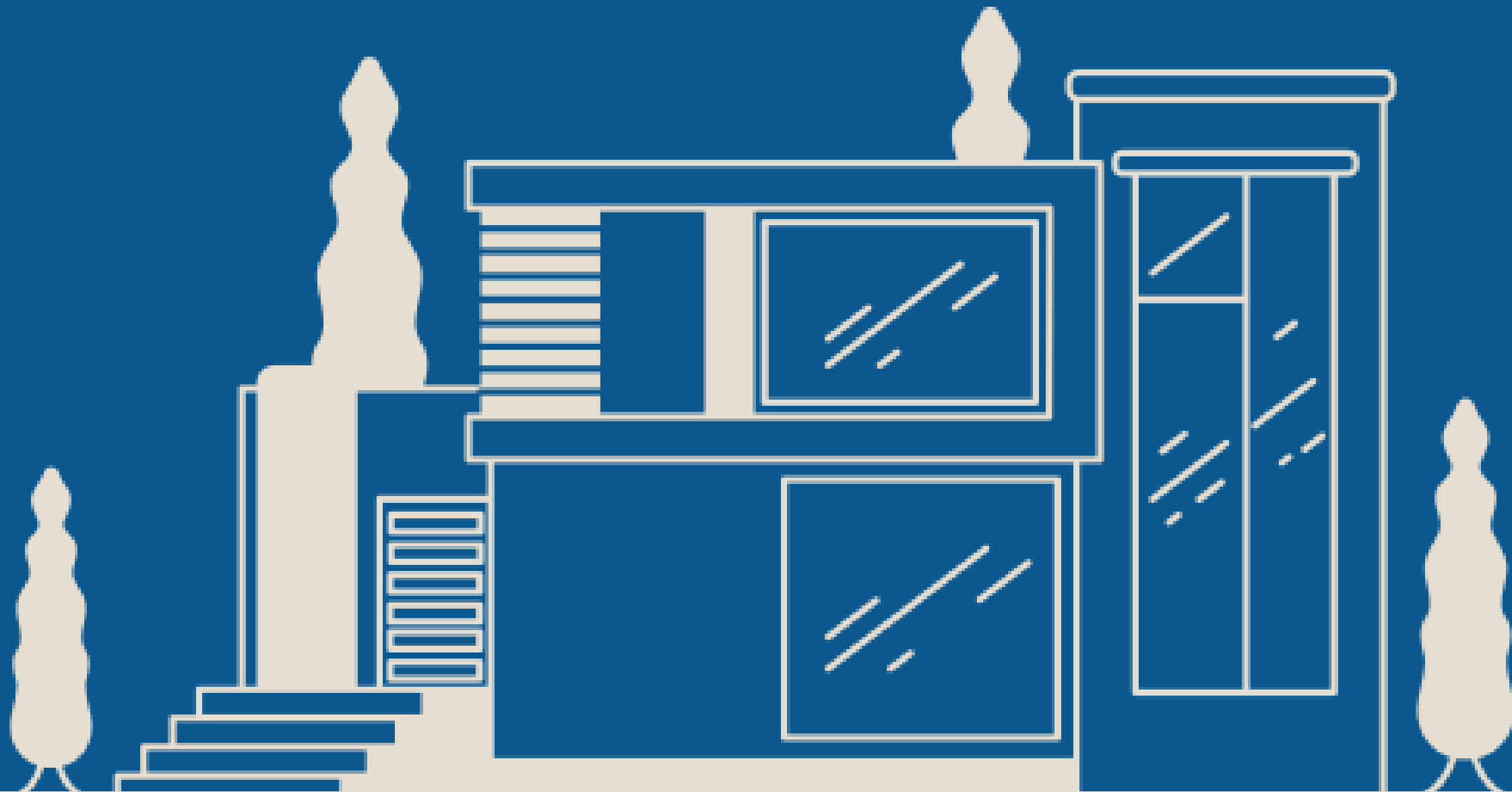
