Background

- Residents raised concerns about improper parking in the Erindale Village area.
- Recreation and Culture staff have continued to monitor the situation.

Signage Update

- Staff will install new signage stating: “Parking is for the Hall and for events held on its premises” by end of March.
- Signage is being installed as an interim measure while further monitoring continues.

Next Steps

- Staff will provide photos once the signage is installed.
- Photos will be shared with residents once received.
- Staff will continue to assess and make adjustments as needed.

Speeding Regulations & Additional Stop Signs in the Village

Jarvis Street, Adamson Street and Proudfoot Street - Speed Study Results (November 2025)

Jarvis Street

- 85th percentile speed: 41 km/h
- Average speed: 33 km/h
- Acceptable for a 40 km/h zone

Adamson Street

- 85th percentile speed: 40 km/h
- Average speed: 31 km/h
- Acceptable for a 40 km/h zone

Conclusion:

- No speeding concern identified
- No physical traffic calming or police enforcement recommended

Parking Accommodations for Future Events at Erindale Park

- The Great Outdoors Comedy Fest team reconvenes in March 2026 for discussion.
- They will fully re-engage with City of Mississauga staff at that time to develop the September 2026 transportation plan.
- Councillor commits to hosting a meeting in May 2026 with Tourism Mississauga

Community Hall and Parkette Renovation Plans

- As part of the 2026 Capital Budget submission, Facilities and Property Management has included a site and facility renewal project for Erindale Community Hall.
- The project is budgeted at \$1.5M, with work planned across two years, 2026 and 2027.
- Completion is aligned with the Hall's 100th Anniversary in 2028.

Site Improvements

- Parking lot resurfacing and repainting
- Flagpole restoration
- New exterior signage

Accessibility Upgrades

- Improvements to both the site and interior areas
- Accessible parking and passenger loading zone
- Updated signage and ADOs

Renovations

- Window replacements
- Masonry repointing
- Kitchenette upgrades
- New flooring
- Mechanical and electrical updates
